<b>Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- refresh and broaden one's command of French</li><li>- improve oral skills to feel more confident</li><li>- make integration easier with ESA students</li><li>- become acquainted with the local environment (everyday life around the college and city)</li><li>- Methodological tools for written and oral skills (group A)</li></ul>						
<b>Contents</b>	This intensive session will alternate classes focusing on language skills (an average of two classes a day with two different lecturers), thematic classes in French (« Vivre en France », « Découverte de l'Anjou viticole »..), cultural visits (Angers, countryside around Angers) and technical visits (visit to cellars...). Finally, some personal work (individual and group work) will be requested in addition to classes.						
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Please note that these courses are not aimed at beginners but rather at students with an elementary or intermediate level of French, who lack confidence and have difficulties speaking, or at students with an advanced level and wishing to acquire methodological tools.						
<b>Teaching methods</b>	Students are divided into three different groups: B2/C1: advanced B1: intermediate A2: elementary						
<b>Assessment</b>	The attendance of the French session accounts for 4 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer System), divided up as follows: Attendance = 0,5 Personal work / written work submitted = 0,5 Audio comprehension (A2, B1) – Methodological work (B2/C1) = 1 Final oral exam = 2

<b>Prerequisites</b>	Please note that this course is not aimed at beginners but rather at students with an elementary or intermediate level of French, who lack confidence and have difficulties speaking.						
<b>Teaching methods</b>	Students are divided into two groups: B1/B2: intermediate A2: elementary  Each group attends one 2-hour class a week for a total of 20 hours + Exams						
<b>Assessment</b>	The attendance of this module accounts for 2 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer System), divided up as follows: Attendance/Classe participation: 1 Exam: 1  One 2 hour written exam and a 15-min oral exam will take place at the end of the course (mid-December 2009).  OPTIONAL: Preparing for the "TFI" ( <i>Test de Français International</i> ) For those students interested in the TFI, the exam will take place at ESA in December. Four 1,5 hour preparation classes will be taught before the exam.
