

## ECTS GRADING SCALE FOR BACHELOR AND MASTER STUDY PROGRAMMES

ESA uses a **grading system of 0-20**. To validate a course or module, the student must have a mark greater than or equal to 10/20.

**ESA applies the ECTS system** developed by the European Commission. The value of a module or course is expressed in ECTS credits. 1 ECTS equals to 25 hours of work for a student (including face-to-face time with teachers, personal working time and assessment time).

The following scale of grades used at ESA Angers is a part of every transcript of records.
